DIRECTIONS RUBBER STAMPS DOLL BACKS • CHARMS

Stamp a dress and face of your choice onto cardstock. Stamp doll back keeping in mind that some of the design will show. Add color to both pieces with Distress Inks, water colors, colored pencils, felt pens...anything in your stash...

Once you have your dress and back decorated, place the dress on top of doll back, line them up and trim edges of back as needed. Make sure that you have matching "shoulder" space on both pieces, for this is where they will be held together with the arms and brads.

Make two holes at the bottom of the doll back for the brads and legs. You can make a small hole with a Japanese Screw Punch, an awl, or paper punch. Attach the legs onto the doll back with brads. If you cut pantaloons into the back, place legs on the back side of the doll back.



Place dress on top of doll back, line them up and trim as needed. Make sure that you have "shoulder" space on both pieces, because this is where both pieces will be held together with the arms and brads. Place the two layers together, make holes at the shoulder for the arms. Attach the arms with the brads, putting the brad through the arm and the two layers of paper. Open the brads in the back to secure.

Glue the head onto the "neck" section of the back! Trim the top of the doll shape behind the face if necessary.
