Spider an Pumpkin Ideas!!!

These are VERY EASY projects that can go in many directions!!!
Table decorations, pin cushions, earrings, pins, necklaces...
Have fun, think outside of the traditional Halloweeny Box!



PUMPKIN PATCH

Gather thread such as pearl cotton, embroidery thread and needle.

Knot the thread and sew up through the middle of the bead securely anchoring and hiding the knot in the hole.

Bring the needle and thread around the edge of the bead and go back up through the original hole to create indentation in the pumpkin.

Pull tight and repeat 5 or 6 times. You might want to secure the thread as you go along to hold it in place.

Cut little leave out of flat felt and attach to the top.

Make a stem from flat felt, beads, twigs, pipe cleaners.

The pumpkins can be needle felted, beaded, embroidered, anything that you can think of!

Don't be limited by traditional colors!



Spider Bodies and pumpkins can be decorated with the same materials.

To create Legs...traditionally eight in number, pipe cleaners or wire are good choices.

The legs can go right through the hole in the middle of the bead.

Wrap one wire around the others right at the bead to secure

Both can be decorated by wrapping cloth, ribbon, yarn or threads.

Add seed bead or "E" beads to the wire.
